Fourteen great days (28th March -10th April) with the Lord in Njinikom and Fundong in mission with Students and young church leaders. This program was designed to help strengthen our Student Venture ministry in Njinikom and Fundong and also to partner with young church leaders and ignite them for ministry through a Mission Seminar and 5 days of practical field work in villages. 107 leaders were trained in connecting the lost to Christ and to be involved in a life- changing discipleship towards the **"Battle for Africa 2020"**. *Islam continue to descend towards sub sahara Africa and remains a big threat to the advacement of Christianity. For 4 nights, the team projecting 8 Jesus Films in a large screen in 4 different villages. Hundreds of people each night turned out to watch the Film in Kom and pidgin language. It was such an experience for the first time as the team descended to the field with zeal for Christ, evangelizing and inviting men and women for the film show. A total of **2090** people heard the true gospel through the crusades and one on one sharing in homes. A total of **836** people gave their lives to Christ. Many groups were formed to continue follow up with

In kikwini multitudes of people who gave their lives to Christ, had many prayer needs. This area is a strong hold in the land. It was a long counseling and prayer session that took the team up to mid night that day. A child of about 10 years saw how Jesus was been nailed on the cross and wept bitterly. When the alter call was made, he was the first to jump out to give his life to Christ. Hundreds of them gave their lives to Christ. We really had difficulties to handle the situation well with children between 8 to 12 years. The children workers amongst us from churches were few. The Full Gospel pastor of Njinikom was touched and requested for a special training and modeling program for His entire church .
