*Another funny experience was in Bafut as we went to launch a sport ministry and saw many teenagers gave their lives to Christ. On our way back, the car we had hired developed a big problem and we had to spend many hours close to mid night in the forest. It frustrated many of us yet we were not crushed and thank God for the experience.*

**A Blind church!** Ngala is a student in National Polytechnique Bambui with great potentials and led a prayer cell where they knew him as a great local pastor with a life to emulate. He attended our training seminar in November and testified that during one of the messages he found himself a naked sinner. He had known for years that he was a Christian though he could not testify when he did that. After given his life to Christ he experienced great joy. He felt bad for serving God in His own strength.
